- about a BelleII Starter Kit in Italy?
- starter kit is a good entry point for newcomers to BelleII analysis software
- and it has evolved to some more complex, physics oriented stuff lately
- Setup by **Documentation, Training and Software outreach** (Ilya Komarov) the weekend before a B2GM
- lately also off-Japan have been organized
 - ▶ **European Belle II Starter Kit Workshop, 7-9 January 2019, MPI, Munich**
- typical schedule: three days
 - ▶ Beginner session
 - ★ Setup environment and connections, GIT, jupyter and Pandas, basf2: building of steering file and first analysis: heavily hands on
 - ▶ Advanced (partally in parallel with beginner)
 - ★ lecture on advanced topics (physics at B-factory, PID, continuum suppression, flavour tagger, vertex reconstruction, Multivariate, deep learning, condition database. . .) plus a bit of hands on
 - ▶ Grid analysis
 - ★ gbasf2 tutorial
 - ▶ Hand-on session
 - ★ A set of task are assigne to people, which should try to produce some results using what they learned.

Why an Italian event

- we do have the expertise in many different field
- **can be useful for beginner:**
 - ▶ *how do I start to analyze $B_0 \rightarrow XYZ$?*
- **can be very useful for advanced:**
 - ▶ *I do have a well defined task for my work, and I already know many of the tools, but am I using them correctly?*
 - ▶ *Is there a better way or better tool?*
 - ▶ *I do have specific question which I'd like to discuss with expert people*
- also good to build an "italian" community for the analysis, exploiting synergies, distributed expertise,
- good way to describe the italian facilities for BelleII (eg Pisa farm, Napoli T2, other?)

When, where, etc?

- **When:** not too close to B2GM, not too clashing with start of data taking
 - ▶ Possibly late spring (april-may) ?
- **Where:** need some facilities, nothing fancy (adequate working room, network, power)
 - ▶ I'll investigate Padova, Umberto Torino, tbd
- **Audience:** at B2GM we have about 30/40 people (beginners+advanced).
 - ▶ The Eu-B2-ST total is ~ 35 participant
 - ▶ goal about 15-20 people (all included)?
- **Lenght:** three days?
 - ▶ tools, lectures, hands-on, questions time, ...
